
Thank you for Academia do Bacalhau's recent donation of \$2,500 to the University of Waterloo in support of the Portuguese Pride and Heritage Campaign.




It was my pleasure to be your guest for such an enjoyable evening of food and fellowship. You made my husband and I feel very welcome.
